This opportunity will enable your child to receive valuable preschool instruction, as well as provide the students with disabilities, age appropriate role models.

We are looking for children who have age appropriate language and behavior. The children must be potty trained and must demonstrate that they are able to be away from home for at least one-half day. Parents will be required to transport to and from school and ensure that consistent attendance occurs with the exception of illness. Parents will also be required to attend Family Involvement events.

The program will be offered M-Th in two sessions; at 9:15-11:45 and 12:55-3:26. Mrs. Allen or Ms. Sandy will be instructing the students and will be assisted by 1 instructional assistant in the classroom

Enrollment is limited in an effort to maintain an appropriate class size. Enrollment in the class will be determined by needs and interview. Interest forms will be accepted until **March 27, 2020.** After that date you will be contacted to set up an interview time. Class list will be determined through a lottery process. If not selected, parents may choose to have their child's name remain on a wait list in the case of a vacancy.
